### Terms of Service, Code of Conduct, and Release of Liability

#### Introduction

The Commonwealth Prevention Alliance (CPA) is committed to providing a safe, professional, and welcoming conference experience for all participants. Please review the following terms carefully before registering for the conference.

#### Assumption of Risk and Release of Liability

In consideration of being permitted to register for, attend, and participate in the 2026 Pennsylvania Prevention Conference, I, on behalf of myself and my spouse, children, guardians, heirs, and legal representatives, agree to release, waive, and covenant not to sue the Commonwealth Prevention Alliance (CPA) and its officers, directors, employees, contractors, agents, instructors, speakers, volunteers, members, sponsors, vendors, venue operators, and other participants (collectively referred to as the 'Released Parties') from any and all liability for injury, illness, loss, or damage that may arise from participation in the Conference.

This includes, but is not limited to, any claims related to personal injury, illness, property damage, or death that may occur while participating in conference activities or while present at conference facilities, except to the extent caused by the gross negligence or willful misconduct of the Released Parties.

I understand that participation in events involving travel, public gatherings, and conference activities carries inherent risks, and I voluntarily assume those risks.

#### Indemnification

I agree to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the Released Parties from any claims, damages, losses, liabilities, costs, or expenses (including reasonable attorney fees) arising out of or related to my participation in the Conference.

#### Conference Policies

I agree that my registration is personal and may not be transferred to another individual without prior authorization from CPA. I further agree to comply with all conference policies, venue policies, and any applicable public health or safety guidelines issued by relevant authorities or the event venue at the time of the Conference.

#### Code of Conduct

The Commonwealth Prevention Alliance (CPA) is committed to maintaining a professional, welcoming, and respectful environment for all conference participants. All attendees, speakers, sponsors, volunteers, and staff are expected to conduct themselves in a respectful and professional manner throughout the conference and related activities. Participants are expected to maintain professional and respectful conduct, including appropriate attire for a professional conference environment.

The following behaviors are not acceptable:

- Harassment, intimidation, or discrimination of any kind
- Disruptive behavior during sessions or conference activities
- Threatening language or conduct
- Unwelcome physical contact or inappropriate comments
- Excessive intoxication or unsafe behavior
- Unauthorized solicitation or promotional activity

CPA reserves the right to take any action deemed appropriate to maintain a safe and professional conference environment. This may include removal from sessions or the conference without refund. Participants who experience or witness inappropriate behavior are encouraged to report the matter to CPA staff or conference organizers.

### **Media Release**

I grant permission to CPA to photograph, record, or otherwise capture my image or likeness during the Conference and to use these materials in promotional materials, publications, social media, or other communications related to CPA's work and programs.

### **Event Cancellation or Changes**

CPA reserves the right to cancel, postpone, or modify the Conference due to circumstances beyond its control, including but not limited to acts of nature, public health concerns, venue issues, labor disputes, or other unforeseen events. In the event of cancellation, CPA's liability shall be limited to the refund of registration fees paid to CPA.

This agreement shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
