Terms of Service, Code of Conduct, and Release of Liability

Introduction

The Commonwealth Prevention Alliance (CPA) is committed to providing a safe, professional, and welcoming experience for all participants in its training sessions. Please review the following terms carefully before registering for the September 16, 2026 Training Session, to be held at Jewish Family and Children's Service of Greater Philadelphia.

Assumption of Risk and Release of Liability

In consideration of being permitted to register for, attend, and participate in the September 16, 2026 CPA Training Session at Jewish Family and Children's Service of Greater Philadelphia, I, on behalf of myself and my spouse, children, guardians, heirs, and legal representatives, agree to release, waive, and covenant not to sue the Commonwealth Prevention Alliance (CPA) and its officers, directors, employees, contractors, agents, instructors, speakers, volunteers, members, sponsors, vendors, venue operators, and other participants (collectively referred to as the 'Released Parties') from any and all liability for injury, illness, loss, or damage that may arise from participation in the Training Session.

This includes, but is not limited to, any claims related to personal injury, illness, property damage, or death that may occur while participating in training session activities or while present at training session facilities, except to the extent caused by the gross negligence or willful misconduct of the Released Parties.

I understand that participation in events involving travel, public gatherings, and training session activities carries inherent risks, and I voluntarily assume those risks.

Indemnification

I agree to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the Released Parties from any claims, damages, losses, liabilities, costs, or expenses (including reasonable attorney fees) arising out of or related to my participation in the Training Session.

Training Session Policies

I agree that my registration is personal and may not be transferred to another individual without prior authorization from CPA. I further agree to comply with all training session policies, venue policies, and any applicable public health or safety guidelines issued by relevant authorities or the event venue at the time of the Training Session.

Code of Conduct

The Commonwealth Prevention Alliance (CPA) is committed to maintaining a professional, welcoming, and respectful environment for all training session participants. All attendees, speakers, sponsors, volunteers, and staff are expected to conduct themselves in a respectful and professional manner throughout the training session and related activities. Participants are expected to maintain professional and respectful conduct, including appropriate attire for a professional training environment.

The following behaviors are not acceptable:

- Harassment, intimidation, or discrimination of any kind
- Disruptive behavior during sessions or training session activities
- Threatening language or conduct
- Unwelcome physical contact or inappropriate comments
- Excessive intoxication or unsafe behavior
- Unauthorized solicitation or promotional activity

CPA reserves the right to take any action deemed appropriate to maintain a safe and professional training environment. This may include removal from sessions or the training session without refund. Participants who experience or witness inappropriate behavior are encouraged to report the matter to CPA staff or training session organizers.

Media Release

I grant permission to CPA and Jewish Family and Children's Service of Greater Philadelphia to photograph, record, or otherwise capture my image, voice, and likeness during the Training Session and to use these materials for media purposes, including in promotional materials, publications, social media, and other communications related to CPA's work and programs. I release CPA and Jewish Family and Children's Service of Greater Philadelphia from any claims arising from the use of my image, voice, or likeness for these purposes.

Event Cancellation or Changes

CPA reserves the right to cancel, postpone, or modify the Training Session due to circumstances beyond its control, including but not limited to acts of nature, public health concerns, venue issues, labor disputes, or other unforeseen events. In the event of cancellation, CPA's liability shall be limited to the refund of registration fees paid to CPA.

Electronic Communications

By registering for the Training Session, I consent to receive communications from CPA via email regarding training session updates and related information.

Governing Law

This agreement shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

By completing the training session registration, I acknowledge that I have read, understood, and agreed to these Terms of Service, Code of Conduct, and Release of Liability. If I do not agree to these terms, I will discontinue my registration for the Training Session.
